

TASK ORGANIZATION: MCB ONE TWENTY-ONE (Herein known as the Battalion)

1. SITUATION. In accordance with references (a) and (b), the Battalion is undergoing a training and organizational period. As part of this training, the Battalion will conduct training in individual combat and military tactics at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina under the following conditions.

a. Enemy forces. None

b. Friendly forces. SERVLANT 20TH NCR
 FMFLANT CBC, GULFPORT
 MARCORBASE, CAMLEJ

c. Attachment. Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company from MCB SIX

2. MISSION. Pursuant to reference (a) and (b), the Battalion is to deploy to Camp Lejeune, in conjunction with military training requirements, for the operational readiness of Naval Construction Battalions.

3. EXECUTION. When directed in May 1967, the Battalion will depart CBC, Gulfport and deploy for a period of approximately three weeks. While in transit and during the training period, the Battalion will maintain readiness conditions required by its assigned contingency designation.

4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS.

a. Standard operational procedures, set forth by reference (c), will be followed.

b. Leave will be administered in accordance with reference (d).

c. Equipment assignments are made by Annex B.

d. Authority to deploy an advance party is granted.

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5. COMMAND AND SIGNAL:

- a. The Commanding Officer is hereby directed to report to the CG, MARCORBASE, Camp Lejeune in accordance with Article 1324, U. S. Navy Regulations.
- b. Movement Reports will be made in accordance with reference (e).
- c. Submit requests to CG, MARCORBASE, Camp Lejeune for Communication Guard.
- d. Direct liaison is authorized with MCB SIX, the MARCORBASE and component activities.

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
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ANNEX B
EQUIPMENT ASSIGNMENT

1. The USN equipment authorized for this deployment is listed on the EAM Listing which will be forwarded under separate cover.
2. Reference (f) sets forth the requirements for control and management reporting of the equipment assignment.
3. The USN equipment required for this training is located at Camp Lejeune in the custody of the Motor Transport Officer whose telephone number is 7-3134 or 7-5736. The equipment can be drawn from the Motor Transport Officer on Form DD 1150, signed by the Battalion C.O. or his representative. Upon completion of the field training at Camp Lejeune, the equipment will be transferred back to the Motor Transport Officer utilizing Form DD 1150 and signed for by Motor Transport Officer or his representative. A copy of the executed transfer of custody for each piece of USN equipment will be forwarded to the 21st NCR. At the time of transfer, a complete Shop Repair Order (NAVDOCKS 1948) will be submitted with each piece of equipment, showing parts required (manufacturers' part number) and work necessary to place equipment in E-1 condition. A copy of the Shop Repair Orders will be forwarded to Code R60 of the 21st NCR.
4. During the training deployment and while the equipment is being utilized by the Battalion, the Battalion will be responsible for all maintenance and minor repairs required to maintain the equipment in E-1 condition. Funds required for procurement of repair parts will be provided by the CBLANT Logistics Officer.
5. Equipment requiring major repairs will be turned in to the Motor Transport Officer who will effect such repairs as may be necessary.
6. In accordance with reference (f), the 512 Report on all USN equipment will be completed and forwarded to 21st NCR Code R60 within five (5) days after the return of the Battalion to CBC, Davisville.
7. The Dispatchers Log, DD 1359, will be maintained on a daily basis and all logs will be submitted to the 21st NCR Equipment Officer upon completion of the training at Camp Lejeune.
8. All USN equipment assigned is to be used for official business only.

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ANNEX C
PUBLIC AFFAIRS

1. MISSION. Collect and disseminate public affairs material that will illustrate the defensive, military posture and smartness of today's Seabees.

2. EXECUTION.

a. The release of public affairs material in connection with this deployment shall be in accordance with references (g) and (h).

b. Extreme care must be exercised to ensure that public affairs releases conform with the following.

(1) Do not make reference to any aspect of the deployment which may be considered classified.


(2) Do not contain any material which may reflect with discredit on the United States or any branch of the U. S. Armed Forces.

(3) Do not contain any material which tends to degrade or ridicule the customs or living conditions of the area where employed.

c. News releases will be made only through the operational/area Commander.

d. A copy of each release will be forwarded to this Headquarters with your Distribution List.

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
