COMMANDING OFFICER

EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Commander Harold Koopman was born and maintains a home in Grand Rapids, Michigan. He is a graduate Civil Engineer from Michigan State College and a Registered Professional Engineer in that State. His engineering career was spent in highway, bridge and airfield construction. He was called back to active duty in September 1950 from his work as Construction Engineer for Kent County, Michigan.

He served in the U. S. Army in WW I and in the Navy in WW II as a Lieut. and LCDR. in the CEC. His thirty months overseas duty in WW II was with the 61st CB's starting at Guadalcanal and ending with the Leyte invasion. He headed the CB Volunteer Unit in Grand Rapids after the war and later the Organized Unit when it was authorized. He has been acting as Executive Officer of Amphibious Construction Battalion One since his recall, serving in Coronado, Japan and Korea.

To the men and officers, USN and USNR, who carried on the spirit of "Can Do" from the Seabees of World War II, and developed the one and only Acey-Bone from a peace-time training group into the effective, smoothly operated, war strength battalion that it is today.

HISTORY OF THE BATTALION

The Battalion was commissioned at Camp Endicott, Rhode Island, in 1943 as the 104th Naval Construction Battalion. Its World War II tour included Camp Holliday, Gulf Port, Mississippi, in 1943; Gamadodo, New Guinea 1944; Australia 1944; and Leyte, Philippine Islands in 1945. It was decommissioned in Leyte after the war in 1945. In 1947 it was reactivated for pontoon equipment training duty at Coronado, California and in October 1950 its name was changed to Amphibious Construction Battalion ONE.

CDR A. C. HUSBAND, CEC, USN, was the Officer in Charge of the reactivated Battalion from 6 March to August 1947. He was relieved by CDR J. P. PLICHTA, CEC, USN, who served until July 1949. His relief was CDR A. T. ROTH, CEC, USN, whose tour ended in November 1951. CDR J. F. STANIUNAS was the next Commanding Officer and is acting as such as this book goes to press. LCDR M. T. JACOBS was the Battalion Executive Officer from its reactivation up into the present CO's tour of duty and provided the continuity of experience.

During the years from 1947 to July 1950 the Battalion trained and experimented with pontoon equipment, took part in various landing exercises from the Silver Strand to Alaska to Hawaii, aided in the Point Barrow resupply, and helped to train Reservists.

In July 1950 the situation changed. The Communists attacked southern Korea and help was needed and needed badly.

At Coronado, officers and men of the 104th NCB undertook a readiness program and by July 26, four sections of pontoon causeways and two warping tugs were loaded on LST 1123 and LST 1138 and departed for Yokosuka, Japan. The AKA YANCY, the AKA ALSHAIN and U.S.S. General Wm. M. WEIGEL followed in rapid succession to their destination in Japan.

On 30 August 1950, the LST's were combat loaded. The ACB ONE Detachment embarked for Korea and arrived off WOLMI-DO Island the morning of 15 September. A 5x30 dock section was connected to the beach by two 2x30 causeway sections. The pier immediately went into operation for loading troops and equipment. The 30 ft. tide and the mud flats presented quite a problem, however, the causeway was utilized 24 hours a day.

On D day plus one, a dock section was brought into Inchon Harbor to be used as a tide level landing at "CHARLEY PIER." General McArthur came ashore across this dock on D plus 2 day.

Immediately upon arrival on D day, military installations and a camp was started. On 21 September, ten Seabees recaptured and returned eight steam locomotives to Inchon under mortar and sniper fire.

On 28 September the entire unit was inspected by Rear Admiral J. H. DOYLE, and was given a "WELL DONE".

By 1 October the invasion at Inchon had attained its purpose by splitting the enemy forces which resulted in their retreat. Ships were reloaded and departed for Wonsan on the opposite coast of Korea. During the period from October through December 1950, the Seabees and their equipment assisted in the tremendous job of evacuating thousands of Marines and thousands of tons of equipment.

After the evacuation at Wonsan, the Seabees returned to their advanced base at Yokosuka, Japan. In December 1950 another detachment went to Inchon. During the first part of 1951 the time was spent in improving the technique of making landing operations at Chigasaki.

During the last few months of 1951, various detachments were sent to Korea to aid in the United Nations effort. In recognition of outstanding services rendered under the United Nations Command, personnel of ACB ONE have received three bronze stars, eight commendations with combat "V", Presidential Unit Citation, recommendation for Korean Presidential Unit Citation and numerous letters in recognition of meritorious services.

From January to July 1952, personnel rotated between the forward area in Japan and the rear area at Coronado, California. Personnel were kept in constant training and during this period, various detachments were sent out to Korea and other parts of Japan to undertake important projects to assist the United Nations. For security reasons pertinent information concerning these operations cannot be revealed.

As this book goes to press, the end of the struggle in Korea is not yet in sight. The peace conference between the opposing sides is in progress with few, if any, accomplishments to their credit to bring an end to this struggle. ACB ONE continues to hold itself in complete readiness at its base in Japan, to meet whatever assignment may come its way.

*Named in Honor of Sergeant Irwin A. McGill Troop 6, 5th Cavalry
 in Los Seguros Island in the Admiralty Group, on 4 March 1942.
 Sergeant McGill with a squad of eight men occupied a bivouac which
 was attacked by 200 Japanese Troops. After all but one of his squad
 had been killed or wounded he ordered the remaining men to the rear. He
 then held the bivouac against the enemy until his weapon ceased to
 function. With the enemy five yards away Sergeant McGill charged from
 his position and engaged in hand-to-hand combat until death.
 He had killed 105 of the enemy attackers. Sergeant McGill was
 posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor. The memory of Sergeant
 Irwin A. McGill is dear to the hearts of his fellow soldiers of
 the 5th Cavalry Regiment. His name stand in the highest
 tradition of the United States Army.*

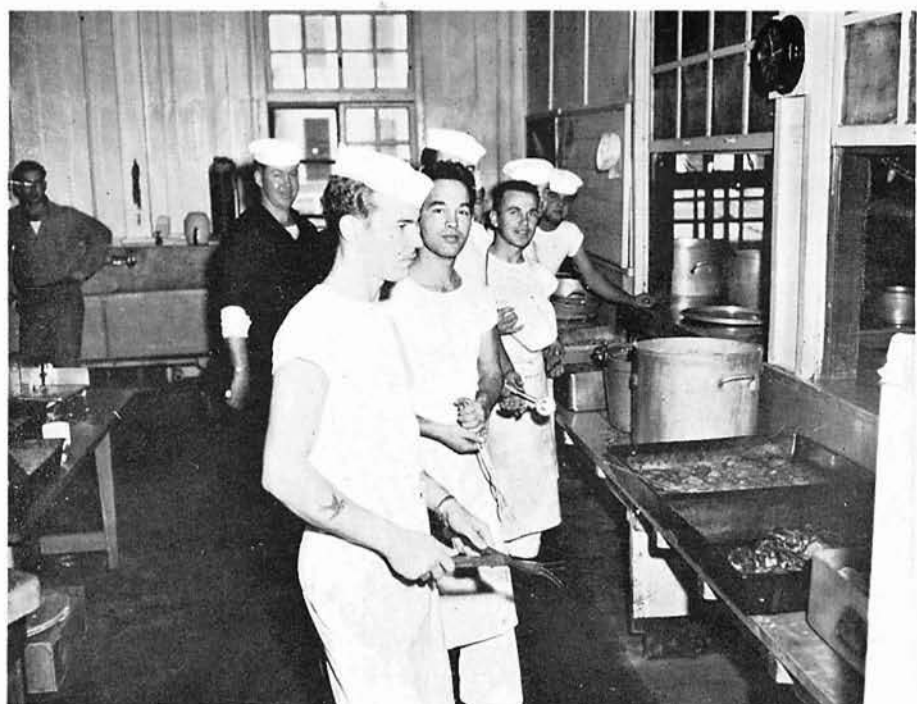

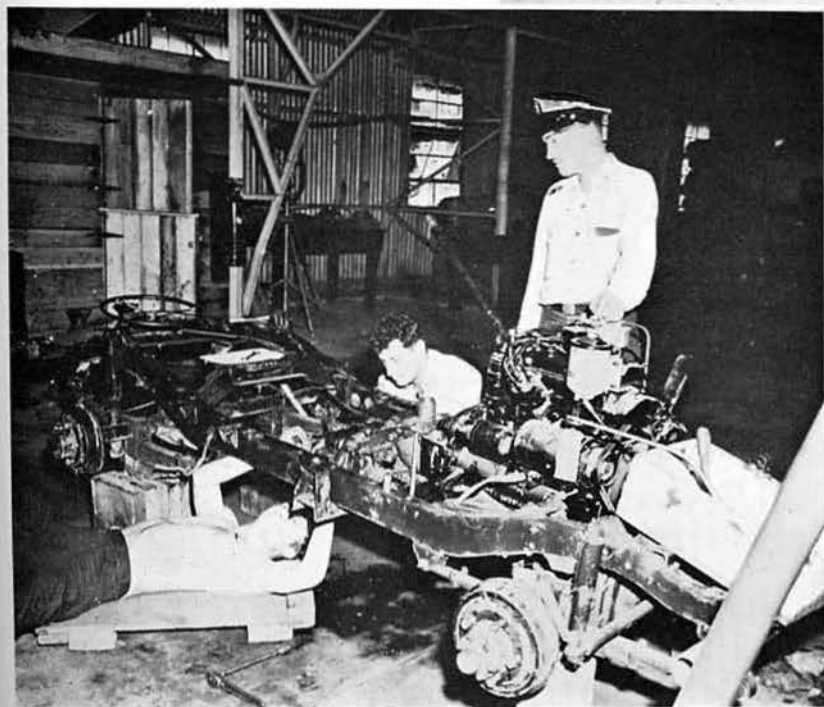

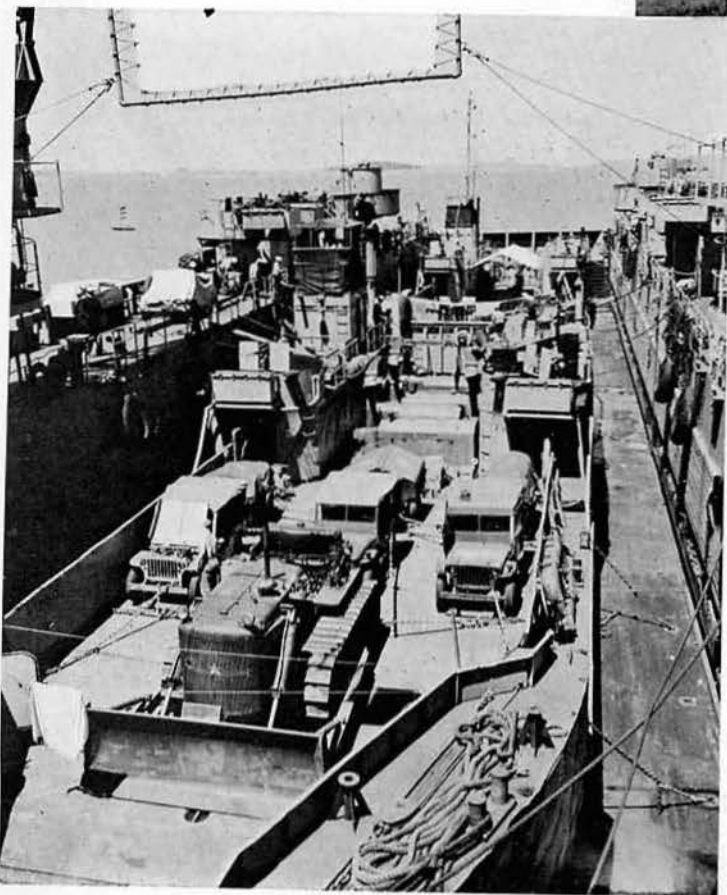

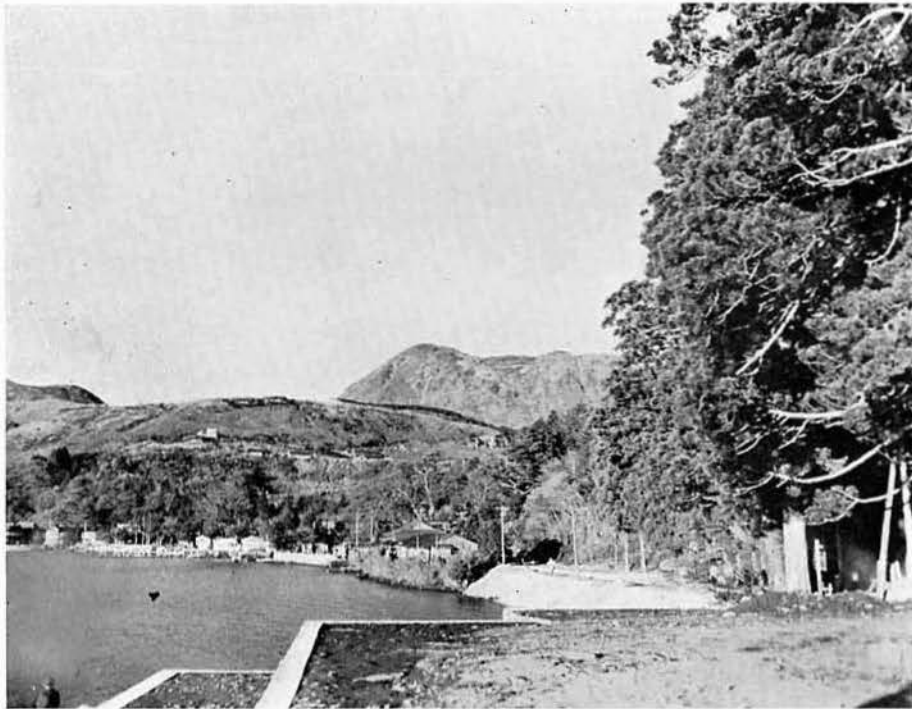
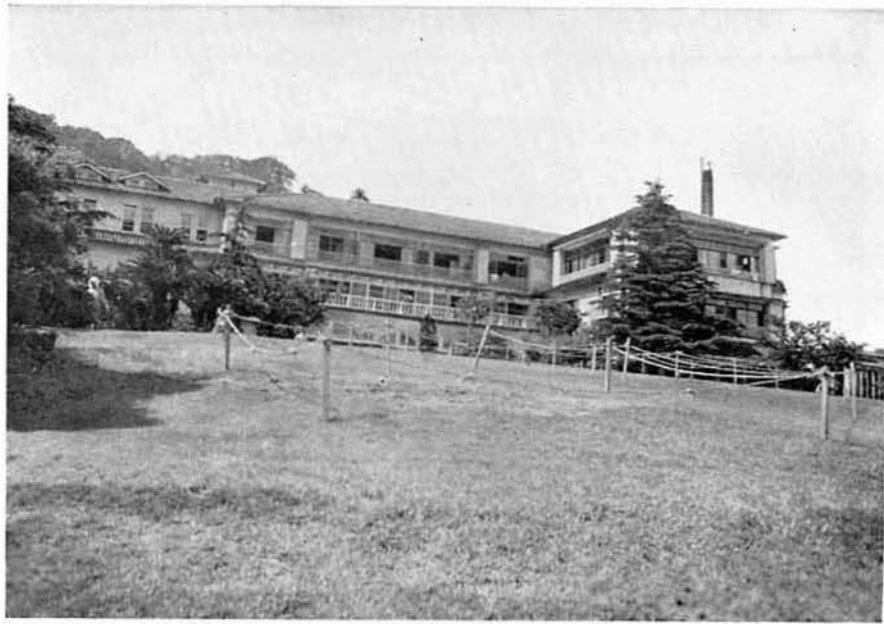


The Dai-Butsu (Great Buddha) is located in the shrine city of Kamakura. The bronze image, weighing 105 tons and standing 43 feet high, was cast in the year 1252 A.D., over 200 years prior to Columbus's discovery of America. It survived a tidal wave in 1495 and the great earthquake of 1926, and is still in a state of excellent preservation and repair.



Eighty four million people live on the Japanese islands. To survive, every square inch of ground must be cultivated and every twig must be utilized. Oxen are used to pull the "honey wagons" and it is normal to see women work with the men on construction projects. Labor is very cheap, the average laborer earning about 120 Yen each day (33 1/3 cents).
