Biographical Note + History

John Francis Lehman, Junior served as the 65th Secretary of the United States Navy (SECNAV) from 5 February 1981 through 10 April 1987 under the Ronald Reagan Administration. Lehman was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to Constance and John Francis Lehman on 14 September 1942. He obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in International Relations from Saint Joseph's University in 1964 where he joined the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) for four years. He also obtained a Bachelor of Arts (Master of Arts) degree with honors from Cambridge University and served three years in the Air Force Reserve while he continued his education. He went on to earn a Master of Arts and Doctorate degrees from the University of Pennsylvania.

In 1977 Lehman founded a consulting company, Abington Corporation and settled in as president and director until 1981, at which time then president, Ronald Reagan, appointed him, at the age of 38, as the U.S. Secretary of the Navy (a position he held until 1987). During this time, John F. Lehman remained on active flight status as a Commander in the United States Naval Reserve having served for 25 years in reserve status.

As Secretary of the Navy, Lehman was responsible for building a 600 ship Navy, establishing a strategy of maritime supremacy, and reforming ship and aircraft procurement. He served as staff member to Henry Kissinger on the National Security Council, as delegate to the Force Reductions Negotiations in Vienna and as deputy director of the U.S. Arms Control and Disarmament Agency.

Secretary Lehman has authored and co-authored several publications on national and international defense and foreign affairs subjects including: *Arms Control*, Ed. by J. E. Dougherty and J. F. Lehman Jr.; *Arms Control for the Late Sixties*, Ed. by J. E. Dougherty and J. F. Lehman Jr.; *The Executive, Congress and Foreign Policy*, by John Lehman; *Aircraft Carriers: The Real Choices*, by John Lehman; and *Beyond the SALT II Failure*, by John Lehman and Seymour Weiss.

Scope + Content

The official files and papers of John F. Lehman Jr., transferred to the Operational Archives in April-May 1987 and February 1989. This collection spans the years from 1973 to 1987. However, the bulk of the documentation dates from the period 1981 to 1987 when Dr. Lehman served as the sixty-fifth Secretary of the Navy.

Approximately half of the materials (7.0 linear feet), consist of Secretary Lehman's subject files. The subject categories were selected and assigned by Secretary Lehman and are arranged by subject/topic. These files lend insight into crises management, defense budget appropriations, reorganization of the Department of Defense and Joint Chiefs of Staff, Navy policy and procurement issues, and programs for shipbuilding, aircraft, and weapon systems. The subject files also contain memoranda, letters, handwritten and typed notes, briefings, speeches, reports, and extracts from published sources.

Secretary Lehman's appointment books and social files, approximately 2.25 feet, span the years from 1981 to 1987. The seven appointment books provide a day to day/hour by hour account of his official business activities. The social files are arranged chronologically by event and include guest lists, menus, entertainment agendas and costs data on receptions, dinners, and cocktail parties hosted by Secretary Lehman in honor of foreign dignitaries, congressmen, and Navy, Marine Corps, and White House officials.

The remainder of the collection, approximately 1.25 feet, consists of a minimal amount of correspondence and published material. The published material includes studies, reports, and newspaper/magazine articles regarding the defense budget, programs, and the future role of the US Navy.
