TENTH BATTALION

Activated at Camp Allen, Norfolk, Va., in the Summer of 1942 the 10th NCB arrived at Pearl Harbor in September. At various intervals, detachments of this outfit operated on several Midpac islands. For continuous service it is one of the oldest Battalions; however, the personnel has been rehabilitated from time to time until practically all of the original personnel has been transferred or discharged. On Nov. 4, 1944, the Battalion was designated as Brigade Headquarters Battalion for Hawaiian Area NCB. The Tenth (Hq.) Advance Detachment of 123 men and three officers were assigned to the 42nd NCB for temporary duty, and on

March 7, 1945, enlisted personnel of the First Detachment transferred to the Fifth Brigade at Guam. In March and April, the Tenth left Pearl Harbor in three sections for Samar, and was stationed on that island in the Philippines at the war's end.
