2. The highlights of the year began with participation in MULTIPLEX 83-1 held in January. COPE THUNDER 83-4 followed in the Republic of the Philippines where the NFO's had the opportunity to work with the Air Force's E-3A AWACS.

In the spring, the "Liberty Bells" became the first VAW squadron to visit the Northern Pacific in over 10 years as part of the three carrier battle group that participated in FLEETEX 83-1. FLEETEX 83-1 provided VAW-115 extensive work with many diverse assets in adverse environmental conditions.


This was followed in July by In June the squadron completed ORE 83. Battle Week in which Liberty worked with the USS NEW JERSEY and the 961st AWACS squadron in addition to the normal battle group complement.

In September, following the downing of KAL 007 by the Soviets, a detachment was ordered to Misawa AB, Japan in support of extended SAR/SALV The end of 1983 saw VAW-115 back in Yokosuka, Japan making preparations for an Indian Ocean deployment.
