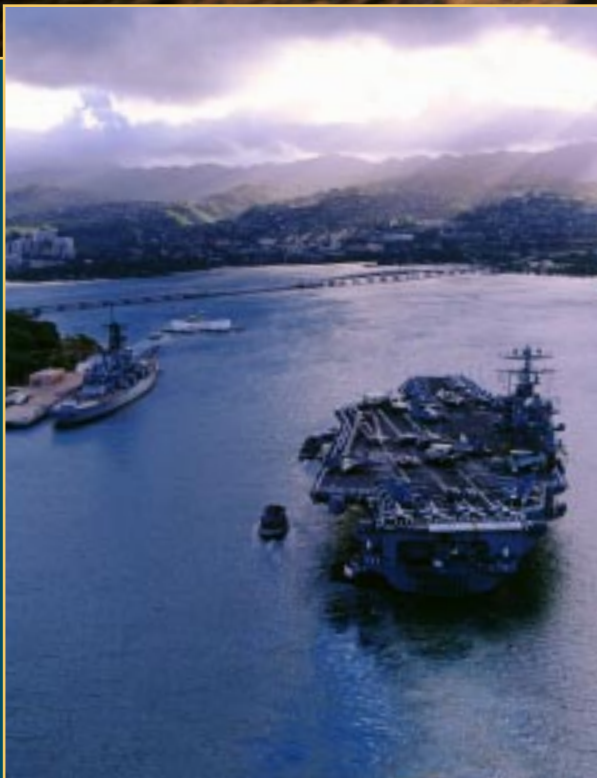


ANA Photo Contest
